

Visa Information

The visa that you require will depend on which course/s you are applying for. Below is a brief description on the visas. More information on which visa you need to apply for will be emailed out once your deposit has been paid.

BDM 1

All BDM 1 students will need to apply for a Temporary Activity Visa (408). Once you have been accepted and paid your deposit you will be sent more information on how to apply for this visa.

Things to Note:

- Capernwray Australia sponsors students on this visa, therefore this visa is solely for the purpose of attending Capernwray
- This visa is for 12 months so if you wish to add on a further course that is possible
- You are NOT allowed to work on this visa
- If you complete only BDM 1 you are allowed 2 weeks of travel either side of the course. If you wish to travel longer after BDM 1 you will need to transfer to a visitor visa.

Aussie Road Trip

If you are coming only for ART you will require a Visitor Visa. There are a number of options here depending on the length of time you wish to stay for. We recommend Electronic Travel Authority (601) or Visitor Visa (600).

BDM 2

Students competing BDM 2 as a stand-alone course have 3 options. As BDM 2 is a 12 week course the visa you choose will depend on how long you wish to stay in the country before or after the course.

- 1. The **Electronic Travel Authority (601)** is the cheapest visa however it only allows you to stay in the country for 3 months (13 weeks) at a time so it does not give you a lot of time for travel.
- 2. **Visitor Visa (600)** allows you to stay for 3, 6 or 12 months giving you extra time to travel however you cannot work on this visa.
- 3. Working Holiday Visa (417 or 462). This visa allows you to stay in the country for 12 months and study for up to 6 months. You are also allowed to work on this visa.

As of 2019 all BDM 2 students will move to the Temporary Activity Visa the same as BDM 1.

Combining 2 or More Courses

If you have applied to or are even considering doing 2 or more courses you will need to apply for the Temporary Activity Visa (408) the same as the BDM 1 students. If you come out on a visitor visa or working holiday visa for one course and then decide that you want to stay on it won't be possible due to visa restrictions on study.
